### Deep End Requirements

- \* Swimmers must be able to complete one full lap of the pool without stopping, using one full length of the crawl stroke and the second is the swimmer's choice of stroke.
- \* If swimmer cannot meet the above requirement, (s)he may use a lifejacket and an adult must accompany swimmer.
- \* Swimming is not allowed in the diving area

### Inclement Weather

The pool will close when thunder is heard (for a half hour after the last rumble), if the bottom cannot be visible (heavy rain), if there is pump failure or evidence of unsafe foreign matter.

## Recreation Center Rules

- ◆ Patrons under 10 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ Food, drink, gum, and pets are not allowed in the **Pool Area OR on Tennis Courts.**
- ◆ Alcoholic beverages, smoking, or illegal substances are not permitted at the Recreation Center.
- ◆ Safe, respectful behavior is expected. Profanity, disrespect, rough housing and harassment will not be tolerated. Offenders will be required to leave the Recreation Grounds.
- ◆ Patrons shall comply with all Town ordinances and rules applicable to the area (posted by the office).

### POOLSIDE:

- ◆ Appropriate bathing attire is required. No cut-off shorts. Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied back.
- ◆ Swim Diapers must be worn by infants/toddlers in the pool area. No diapers or pull-ups in the pool.
- ◆ **Always** shower before entering the pool.
- ◆ Please enter the pool by ladders, diving board or the shallow end **only.** (Playing on the stairs is unsafe.)
- ◆ Please exit the pool by the stairs, ladders, or the shallow end **only.**
- ◆ **No running** in the pool area.
- ◆ Hanging on ladders, stairs or lap lanes is prohibited.
- ◆ Flotation devices must be approved by the lifeguards.
- ◆ Respect lifeguards and do not distract them.
- ◆ Guards will take up to a 15 minute break every hour. Adults may use the pool unsupervised. However, any children are prohibited during this time.

### DIVING and DIVING BOARD RULES:

- ◆ Diving is allowed only from the diving board.
- ◆ Only one person shall be on the diving board at a time.
- ◆ Check the area before diving.
- ◆ Use only one bounce on the board.
- ◆ **Absolutely no flipping and no spinning.**
- ◆ Diver must jump forward, in line with the board.
- ◆ Swimming is not allowed in the diving area.
- ◆ Hanging from the diving board is prohibited.

### TENNIS COURTS:

- ◆ Tennis players have priority for court use.
- ◆ Respect the courts and take care of them.
- ◆ Children should not be on courts without supervision.
- ◆ Tennis Courts may be reserved by contacting the Town Manager's Office (234-9340) and acquiring a permit.

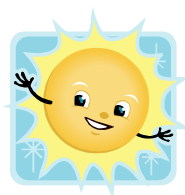
